- 1) Can you confirm that the scope of the project ends at the completion of 100% construction documents and does not include any bidding support or construction administration? Yes, it ends at the completion of the 100% construction documents and does not include any bidding support or construction administration.
- 2) What are the MWBE or SDVOB requirements for this contract? As a direct recipient of funding from the FHWA, we do not have a specific MWBE goal or target. MWBE is a NY State Requirement. Cattaraugus County will follow the guidelines in <u>2 CFR 200.321</u> which applies and does encourage the use of certain firms in alignment with a "good faith effort" to align with programmatic goals
- 3) Has construction funding been secured for all or part of this project? No it has not.
- 4) Is there a preliminary schedule anticipated for bidding and construction of the project? No there is not. It is anticipated that Cattaraugus County will begin the process of applying for construction funds later in the design and alignment process.
- 5) What type of selection process will be used and will it follow the Brooks Act? The selection that will be used will be a qualification-based approach that follows Part 172 (Brooks Act).
- 6) Are there any DBE Requirements? There are no specific Title 23 requirements or goals. Cattaraugus County will follow the guidelines in 2 CFR 200.321 which applies and does encourage the use of certain firms in alignment with a "good faith effort" to align with programmatic goals. The participation of qualified and certified Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) subconsultants may be used as a nominal evaluation criterion where appropriate in accordance with 49 CFR part 26 and a contracting agency's FHWA-approved DBE program.
- 7) Is there a Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for this federally funded project? **No, See** above.
- 8) Does the County anticipate selecting two separate firms for the solicitations, i.e., one firm for the design/alignment and a different firm for the public process? **Yes**
- 9) If one firm is planning to prime both efforts, are two separate responses required or could the firm submit one combined proposal? **Yes**
- 10) The contract period in the RFP indicates January 2024 September 2027. Will this be extended given the RFP/proposal being released in September of 2024? The Contract will be January 2025-September 2027.
