WHEREAS, the Cattaraugus County Bridge Sealing of 22 Bins and Washing of 218 Federal Aid Eligible Structures in Cattaraugus County Project, for various locations in Cattaraugus County, PIN 5761.97 (the "Project"), is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at a ratio of 80% federal funds and 20% non-federal funds, and II. WHEREAS, the County desires to advance the above Project by making a commitment of 100% of the costs of the Construction & Construction Inspection phases of the Project, and III. WHEREAS, various appropriation and revenue accounts must be adjusted, now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby approves the above-described Project, and be it further RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby authorizes the County of Cattaraugus to pay in the first instance 100% of the federal and non-federal shares of the cost of the Construction & Construction Inspection phases of the Project or portions thereof, and be it further III.
