**CANCELING UNENFORCEABLE LIENS  
(City of Olean and Towns of East Otto, Olean and Randolph)**

Pursuant to Section 558 of the Real Property Tax Law.

I. WHEREAS, it is necessary and prudent for the Cattaraugus County Legislature to cancel unpaid taxes where the lien of such taxes is unenforceable, now, therefore, be it

I. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby cancels the lien of taxes on the following properties, as being unenforceable:
