LOCAL LAW NUMBER 8 - 2021 COUNTY OF CATTARAUGUS, NEW YORK

Pursuant to Section 226-b of the County Law and Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 2-1990, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, ENTITLED "A LOCAL LAW REGARDING THE STORAGE, COLLECTION, RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE IN CATTARAUGUS COUNTY"

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Cattaraugus as follows:

SECTION 1. Legislative Intent. The intent of this Local Law is to include additional definitions in Section 2. Definitions, and make clarifications in Section 4. Source Separation, Section 5. Solid Waste Collection, Section 11. Yard Waste Disposal, Section 12. Commercial and Industrial Waste and Commercial and Industrial Recyclable Material, and Section 23. Enforcement: Penalties, contained in Local Law No. 2-1990 (Intro No. 1-1990), as amended, entitled "A Local Law Regarding the Storage, Collection, Recycling and Disposal of Solid Waste in Cattaraugus County".

SECTION 2. Amendment of Local Law No. 2-1990 (Intro No. 1-1990), as Amended. Section 2 of Local Law No. 2-1990 (Intro No. 1-1990), as amended, entitled "A Local Law Regarding the Storage, Collection, Recycling and Disposal of Solid Waste in Cattaraugus County", adopted by the Cattaraugus County Legislature on June 27, 1990, is hereby amended as follows:

- In Section 2. Definitions., delete current subsection 'ZZ. Yard Waste', and replace with the following new subsection: "ZZ. Yard Waste: A type of solid waste to include grass clippings, leaves, cuttings from shrubs, hedges and trees that are less than four (4) inches in diameter and less than four (4) feet in length, excluding stumps; yard waste does not include household waste or recyclable material, as defined herein."
- In Section 4. Source Separation., delete current subsection b., and replace with the following new subsection b.: "The transfer stations established, licensed, or contracted with, by the County shall be for the exclusive use of residents of the County, with the exception of the Village of Gowanda Erie County residents. The County reserves the right to contract with other municipalities for the use of such sites by persons within those municipalities."
- In Section 5. Solid Waste Collection., subsection 5.5, delete: "requirements", and replace with: "specifications:".
- In Section 11. Yard Waste Disposal., delete subsections 11.1 and 11.2, and replace with:
 "11.1 Yard waste shall not be disposed of in any manner that is not in accordance with this Section. Yard waste may be disposed of in a quantity and quality upon such terms and conditions as designated by the Commissioner of Public Works. Stumps of any kind are strictly prohibited from being disposed of at Transfer Stations."
- In Section 11. Yard Waste Disposal., renumber subsection 11.3 to "11.2".
- In Section 12. Commercial and Industrial Waste and Commercial and Industrial Recyclable Material., delete from section title: "Commercial and Industrial".
- In Section 12., subsection 12.1, add: "waste and" before "recyclable".

AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO EXECUTE CONTRACT WITH GENERATIONS FORESTRY, INC. FOR FORESTRY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Pursuant to Sections 215 and 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, Act 651-2016, as amended by Act 342-2019, authorized a contract with Generations Forestry, Inc., P.O. Box 319, 26 Paynes Road, Kane, Pennsylvania 16735, for the provision of services necessary to manage the County's forest lands, the term of which expires November 30, 2021, and
- II. WHEREAS, the County Department of Public Works is desirous of renewing the aforementioned contract, and
- III. WHEREAS, Generations Forestry, Inc., shall provide general professional forestry management services for the County, on an as-needed basis, which shall include the following:
 - Provide professional forestry consulting services as requested by Cattaraugus County,
 - Provide insect and disease control monitoring,
 - Provide forestry regeneration recommendations and monitoring, such as deer fencing and herbiciding,
 - Marking property boundaries,
 - Timber stand improvement work,
 - Management of water runoff and erosion controls,
 - Placement of signage, and
 - Other services that may be needed,

and

IV. WHEREAS, the aforementioned consultant services shall be provided in accordance with the following fee schedule:

Senior Forester (25+ years' experience) \$85.00 per hour Account Manager Forester (10-25 years' experience) \$71.00 per hour Forester (2-10 years' experience) \$60.00 per hour Forest Technicians (1-5 years' experience) \$48.00 per hour,

and

- V. WHEREAS, Generations Forestry, Inc., shall receive from the County a 10% commission on all timber sold for Cattaraugus County, which fee also includes the following services:
 - Pre-salvage harvest;
 - Selectively mark all trees to be harvested;
 - Prepare Timber Sale Prospectus which will include all details of the timber sale, including an
 inventory by diameter class, species and volume of the trees to be sold, and GPS map of
 defined sale area, which is subject to the approval of the County Legislature;
 - Market sale to all reputable buyers in the area;
 - Organize a sealed bid opening under the supervision of the Clerk of the County Legislature and the County Legislature shall award timber cutting contract to high bidder;
 - Assure best management practices for New York State are implemented during harvesting, the sale and clean-up process;
 - Hold performance bond from the timber buyer and close the contract after consultation and approval from the County; and
 - Provide a long-term forest management plan for timbered tracts, including recommended future work and scheduled intervals,

and

- VI. WHEREAS, sufficient funds are included in the budget to cover the cost of the aforementioned services, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a contract, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with Generations Forestry, Inc., for the provision of the above-described forestry management services, for a term commencing December 1, 2021 and terminating December 31, 2023, according to the above-described terms.

OPPOSING INFRINGEMENTS ON THE INALIENABLE RIGHTS OF THE PEOPLE AND DECLARING CATTARAUGUS COUNTY A CONSTITUTIONAL COUNTY AND AMENDING THE MISSION STATEMENT OF THE COUNTY TO CONFORM THEREWITH

Pursuant to Section 153 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, members of the Cattaraugus County Legislature, being elected to represent the people of Cattaraugus County, are duly sworn by their oath of office to uphold the Constitution of the United States and the New York State Constitution and Laws, including the New York State Civil Rights Law, and
- II. WHEREAS, the Cattaraugus County Legislature is determined to stand as a Constitutional County to protect the rights provided to its citizens under the U.S. Constitution and its amendments, and
- III. WHEREAS, such protections will extend to rights specifically enumerated in the Constitution and its amendments, including, but not limited to, rights to freedom of expression, speech, association, religion, press and petition, the right to keep and bear arms, the right to protection of person and property from government overreach and the right not to be deprived of life, liberty or property without due process of law, and
- IV. WHEREAS, such protections will also extend to all other rights neither enumerated in the Constitution nor its amendments, but which exist alongside the same as inalienable, basic, fundamental rights that are so deep rooted in our society that they are deserving of protection from governmental infringement and are thus protected by the Ninth Amendment, including, but not limited to, the right to equality, liberty and the pursuit of livelihood and happiness, and
- V. WHEREAS, the Cattaraugus County Legislature wishes to express its profound commitment to the rights of all citizens of Cattaraugus County to keep and bear arms and proclaim that it is determined to stand as a Constitutional County that recognizes, respects and upholds Second Amendment rights, and states that it will use all legal means at its disposal to oppose, within the limits of the Constitution of the United States and the Civil Rights Law of the State of New York, any efforts to unconstitutionally restrict such rights in order to assure that its citizens will be able to keep and bear arms and use the same in defense of life, liberty and property, whether in a well-regulated militia, or individually, and
- VI. WHEREAS, the Cattaraugus County Legislature stands and will continue to stand in strong opposition to any law that would unconstitutionally restrict, or infringe upon, the above recognized rights, and
- VII. WHEREAS, the goal statement on the Cattaraugus County webpage (www.cattco.org/ government) currently states: "The goal of County government and the County Legislature is to provide the traditional role as an arm of State government, while also taking a more non-traditional role which seeks to establish the County as an agency that analyzes service needs, sorts them in an orderly manner, and realigns and consolidates services so they may be performed most effectively and financed most economically", and
- VIII. WHEREAS, this current mission (goal) statement fails to recognize the Constitutional, historical, and rightful role of the Legislature to act as a check and balance upon not only local executive and judicial branches, but upon the State government itself, and

IX. WHEREAS, this current mission (goal) statement fails to recognize the Constitutional, historical, and rightful role of the legislature as a voice of the People of Cattaraugus County and a guarantor of their liberties, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the mission (goal) statement shall be revised to state: "The goal of the Cattaraugus County Government is to support and respect the Constitution of the United States of America and its amendments, and to provide essential services financed most economically to its citizens. Also, it is to establish an environment in which the citizens of Cattaraugus County can pursue life, liberty, and happiness unencumbered by excessive and oppressive governmental mandates and intrusions into their day-to-day lives. The goal of the government of this County is to uphold the freedoms enshrined in the Bill of Rights. The County Legislature recognizes that governments in the United States of America - at all levels - are to be restrained and limited and that the power of government resides in the people. The Legislators of this County, accept with humility and gratitude the reality that they serve at the consent of the governed and at the will of the people. The Legislators believe in the rule of law, equality before the law, due process, private property protections, and the rights of citizens to pursue their livelihoods without excessive governmental oversight. Wherever possible, the Legislature will encourage local solutions, local funding, and creative approaches to the problems our community encounters. The Legislature stands as a protector between the citizens of this County and the tendency of governments at state and federal levels to advance into territory not their own and consume, rather than secure, the liberties endowed to the people by the Constitution and the Bill of Rights. The County's guide and standard will be the Constitution of the United States and the Founding Documents upon which our Nation, our State, and the local communities of Cattaraugus County are built", and be it further

II. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby expresses its intent to uphold all such rights of the citizens of Cattaraugus County and that public funds, resources, employees, buildings or offices not be used to restrict such rights or to aid or assist in the enforcement of any restriction of the rights granted under the Constitution or its Bill of Rights (such constitutionality to be determined by the Courts), and be it further

III. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature recognizes that Government must be limited and that the people must be free from unnecessary and arbitrary Governmental overreach and intrusions, and be it further

IV. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby declares Cattaraugus County, New York, a Constitutional County, unwavering in its commitment to protect the constitutional rights of its citizens.
