Pursuant to Title 23 U.S. Code and Sections 363, 366 and 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, Act 376-2021 authorized a contract with the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) for the Cattaraugus County Bridge Painting Project: four (4) bridges located within Cattaraugus County, BIN 3322990, 3322230, 3321320 and 3322890, PIN 5763.63, (the "Project"), which is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% federal funds and 20% non-federal funds, and
- II. WHEREAS, the County desires to continue to advance the above Project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-federal share of the costs of the Construction & Construction Inspection phase of the Project, PIN 5763.63, and
- III. WHEREAS, this Supplemental Agreement is necessary to provide for an increase in the Construction & Construction Inspection phase of the Project by \$10,000.00, and
- IV. WHEREAS, various appropriation and revenue accounts must be adjusted in order to cover the cost of the aforementioned project, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby approves the above-described Project, as amended, and be it further
- II. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby authorizes the County of Cattaraugus to pay in the first instance 100% of the federal and non-federal shares of the cost of the Construction & Construction Inspection phase of the Project, or portions thereof, and be it further
- III. RESOLVED, that the sum of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated, in addition to \$535,000.00 previously appropriated for the Project's Construction & Construction Inspection phases via County Resolution No. 376-2021, adopted October 13, 2021, and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase of the Project, and be it further
- IV. RESOLVED, that in the event the amount required to pay the full federal and non-federal shares of the cost of the Project's Construction & Construction Inspection phase exceeds the amount appropriated above, the County of Cattaraugus shall convene its Legislature as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the NYSDOT thereof, and be it further
- V.
