- of \$263,301.00 per year for a five (5) year period, with final grant awards contingent upon the review and approval of the Office of the State Comptroller, and
- III. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Healthy Neighborhoods Program is to provide preventive environmental health services to targeted geographic areas, and
- IV. WHEREAS, the grant funds, if awarded, will provide the resources needed to address significant public health issues in targeted areas to provide healthier home environments, and
