WHEREAS, Act 42-2021 authorized approval of a contract with Cattaraugus Rehabilitation Center, Inc. d/b/a Intandem and NYSARC, Inc., Cattaraugus Niagara Counties Chapter d/b/a Intandem, 1439 Buffalo Street, Olean, New York 14760, for the provision of adult day care services and comprehensive programs and service facilities for the mentally ill, developmentally disabled, and physically handicapped residents of Cattaraugus County, the term of which expired December 31, 2021, and

II. WHEREAS, the Department of Community Services is desirous of continuing the provision of the aforementioned services, and

III. WHEREAS, Cattaraugus Rehabilitation Center, Inc. d/b/a Intandem and NYSARC, Inc., Cattaraugus Niagara Counties Chapter d/b/a Intandem can provide comprehensive programs and services for the mentally ill, developmentally disabled and physically handicapped individuals for an amount not to exceed \$265,551.00, to be paid as invoiced, and

V. WHEREAS, these programs are 100% state funded, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a contract, between the Cattaraugus County Community Services Board with Cattaraugus Rehabilitation Center, Inc. d/b/a Intandem and NYSARC, Inc., Cattaraugus Niagara Counties Chapter d/b/a Intandem, to signify the County's approval, for the provision of the above-described services, for a term commencing January 1, 2022 and terminating December 31, 2022, according to the above-described terms, and be it further

II. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, further authorized and directed to execute contract amendments, upon notification of award, for the allocation of additional state aid funding or cost of living adjustments (COLAs) or reduction in funding for this program, and be it further
