Pursuant to Title 23 U.S. Code and Sections 363, 366 and 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, the Cattaraugus County Bridge Painting Project: four (4) bridges located within the Towns of Leon, Little Valley and Freedom in Cattaraugus County, BIN 3321630, 3322260, 3322380, and 3322180 (the "Project"), is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% federal funds and 20% non-federal funds, and
- II. WHEREAS, the County desires to advance the above Project by making a commitment of 100% of the federal and non-federal share of the costs of the Construction & Construction Inspection phase of the Project, PIN 5763.68, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby approves the above-described Project, and be it further
- II. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby authorizes the County of Cattaraugus to pay in the first instance 100% of the federal and non-federal shares of the cost of the Construction & Construction Inspection phase of the Project, or portions thereof, and be it further
