# AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO EXECUTE GRANT DOCUMENTS WITH NEW YORK STATE OFFICE FOR THE AGING FOR 2020-2021 SUPPLEMENTAL NYS UNMET NEED FUNDING AND ADJUSTING VARIOUS APPROPRIATION AND REVENUE ACCOUNTS (Department of Aging)

Pursuant to Older Americans Act Title III-E and Sections 363, 366 and 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$250,000.00 is available through the New York State Office for the Aging for 2020-2021 Supplemental Unmet Needs for the Department of Aging, and
- II. WHEREAS, it is necessary to execute grant documents in order to apply for, and accept, the aforementioned funding, and
- III. WHEREAS, this program is 100% state funded, and
- IV. WHEREAS, various appropriation and revenue accounts must be adjusted in order to receive the aforementioned funding, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute grant documents, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with the New York State Office for the Aging, in order to apply for, and accept, the aforementioned Supplemental NYS Unmet Need funding, for a term commencing April 1, 2021 and terminating March 31, 2022, according to the above-described terms, and be it further
- II. RESOLVED, that upon termination of either state or federal funding for this program, then this program shall be automatically abolished, and be it further
- III. RESOLVED, that such contract shall provide that upon the reduction of any such funding, the County, in its sole discretion, may terminate the contract on thirty (30) days' written notice, and be it further
- IV. RESOLVED, that in the event of any such reduction, the department head involved shall immediately report such occurrence to the Chairman of the Committee to which the department is assigned, who shall add the matter to the agenda of the Committee's next meeting, and be it further
- V. RESOLVED, that the County Administrator is hereby directed to make the following budgetary changes: Increase Estimated Revenue Account:
