- I. WHEREAS, Act 214-2021 authorized the Chairman to apply for funding through the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services for the 2020 Statewide Interoperable Communications Formula-Based Grant (SICG), and
- II. WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has been awarded funding through the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services in the amount of \$684,153.00, and
